Deadline:

March 1st for Fall semester

October 1st for Spring semester

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Application for admission (you can use The Common Application)
- \$50 application fee
- Official transcript with U.S. credit evaluation
- Results of the TOEFL (score 550/79 or above) or IELTS (score 6 or above)
If native English speaker SAT or ACT scores are required
- Completed affidavit of support & proof of funds
- Personal essay on topic of your choice
- 2 Letters of recommendation

TRANSFER STUDENTS ALREADY IN THE U.S.

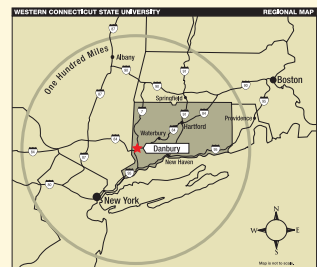
If you currently have an active F-1 or J-1 visa with another university in the United States you must complete a Transfer Verification Form. After a student is accepted we can help them transfer their visa.
