### Reporting of Code of Conduct Violations

in regards to Student Clubs and Organizations, Club Sports, and Student Athletes.

*The Center for Student Involvement (CSI), Department of Recreation and Club Sports, and the Athletics Department follows a standardized process whenever a student, student club, club sport, or athletic team is alleged to have violated University policies, including but not limited to Hazing, Title IX regulations, or Board of Regents (BOR) policies."*

#### **1. Notification of Relevant Authorities**

- The Director of CSI, The Director of Recreation, and the Associate Director of Athletics for compliance will notify the appropriate administrator(s) based on the nature of the offense. This may include:
  - Director of Judicial Affairs
  - Title IX Officer
  - WCSU Police Department
- The Dean of Student Affairs will be notified in cases involving student clubs and organizations or club sports.
- The Director of Athletics and The Associate Director of Athletics for Compliance will be notified for all cases involving student athletes.

**2. Investigation Process** Based on guidance from the notified administrator(s), CSI, Department of Recreation, and Athletics Department will:

- Conduct a thorough investigation, including interviews with witnesses, victims, and alleged perpetrators.
- Collect relevant evidence, which may include:
  - Social media screenshots
  - Emails and text messages
  - Photos, videos, flyers, and other materials
- Submit interview transcripts and all collected evidence to the appropriate administrator.

- Continue the investigation if additional follow-up is requested.

### **3. Enforcement of Sanctions**

- If the University imposes sanctions on the student organization and/or club sports, CSI and the Department of Recreation will be responsible for enforcing them.
- If a student athlete is involved, the university will also impose sanctions on that student.
- If a University Sports Team is involved, the Director of Athletics and/or the Associate Director of Athletics may take measures in regards to any specific teams.

(The Student Code of Conduct can only sanction individual students and any club/organization. The Student Code of Conduct doesn't sanction any sports teams, only individual students on a respective team.)
